



Young Adults Intern Job Description

Duration: Seasonal as determined by the Minister to Young Adults

General Description:

- The Young Adults Intern will serve as an extension of the Young Adults Ministry of Forest Hills and help lead this ministry which includes areas of College Ministry, Young Single Professionals and Young Marrieds.

Supervisor:

- The Young Adults Intern will work under the supervision of the Minister to Young Adults.

Requirements:

- Spirituality: The intern should see themselves as a spiritual mentor and leader for their ministry area. The intern will be expected to always demonstrate the highest level of integrity and Christian witness. (Col. 3:17; 3:23-24)
- Education: All applicants should have completed their first year in college (or equivalent) by the start of the internship.
- Character: The intern should show a growing love for God and the people they serve and exemplify character above reproach. (Mt. 22:36-40)

Job description may include but is not limited to the following:

- Provide leadership and direction to the Young Adults Ministry working closely with the Minister to Young Adults
- Help plan and execute specific events throughout the year including Young Adult outings, retreats, worship nights (Dwell), and other events
- Help oversee the Young Adult Leadership Team (YALT)
- Recruit and lead a Young Adult Quad while interning
- Attend the Sunday School class that is in their stage of life (college, young professional, young married)
- Support the Minister to Young Adults and their assistant with administration tasks as needed
- Facilitate consistent opportunities of relationship-building and discipleship

Pay: \$10 per hour (15-20 hours per week average). Hours are subject to change for special events. Pay is bi-weekly.
