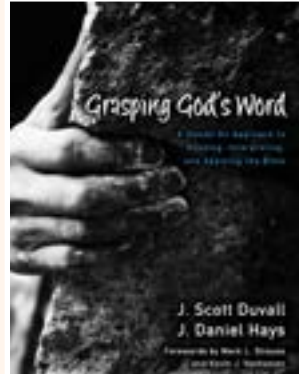

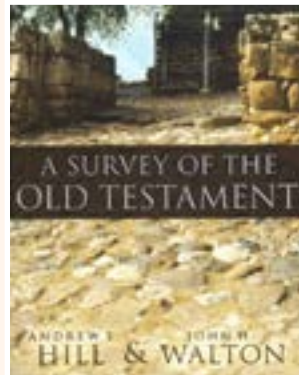

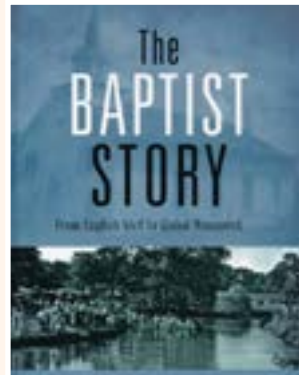


OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY C

exploration of the literary, historical, and theological issues pertinent to each Old Testament book and the Old Testament as a whole. (11 weeks)

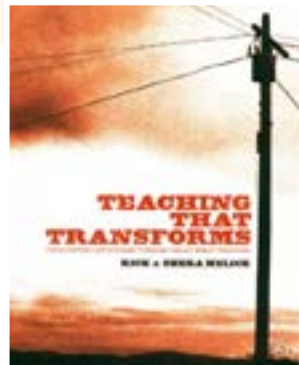


CHURCH HISTORY C

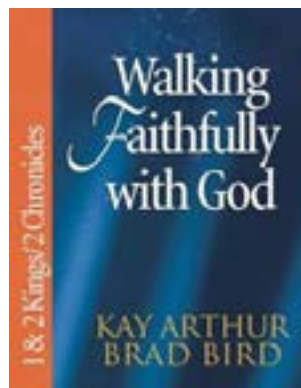
GOD OF FREEDOM

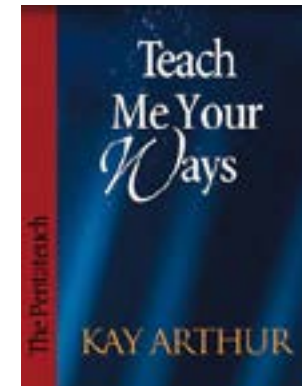

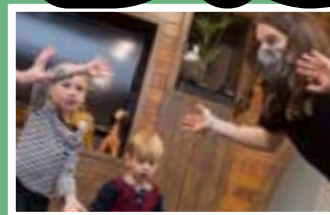
