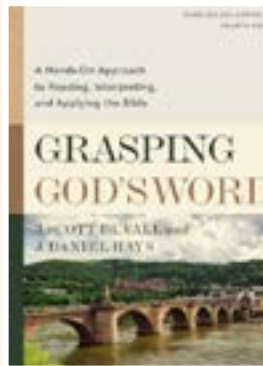


WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU DON'T KNOW WHAT TO DO - A STUDY OF THE BOOK OF JAMES **C**

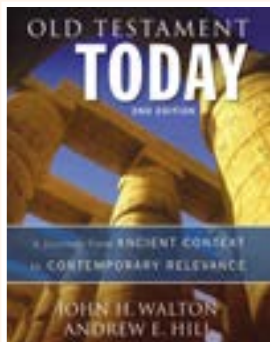


HOW TO STUDY THE BIBLE: GRASPING GOD'S WORD **G**

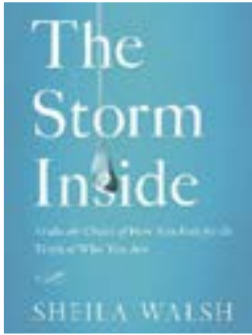

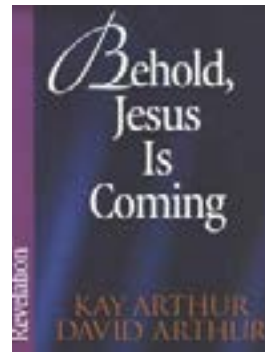

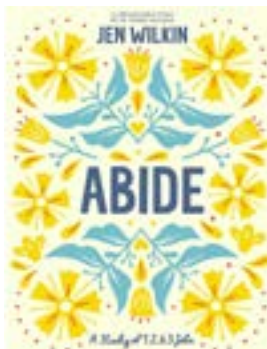
